Reservation, Payment Methods, Implementation Agreement

- 1. The event will take place in person and on site and will be streamed live on an online platform. The participant is responsible for the fulfilment of the requirements such as internet access and the appropriate equipment.
- 2. Upon receipt of the respective invoice payment must be made only by bank transfer to the account specified in the invoice. Please indicate name, invoice number, seminar name and seminar date. For payments from abroad please note the additional transfer fees that may be incurred for international transfers. We do not accept cash or debit card payments. If you cancel after the registration we will, after receipt of a written notice of -cancellation, collect the following fee:
- up to 30 days before the event: 30.00 € booking fee
- to 15 days before the event: 50% of the fee
- thereafter, the entire fee will be charged.
- 3. We refer to the possibility of cancellation insurance. These services aren't offered by the organisers themselves. This may be taken up with external service providers.
- 4. If an advertised training coach is prevented from attending with good cause, this is no reason for a cancellation providing that the organiser provides another trainer in their place who is qualified to the same level.
- 5. Should the course be cancelled for an important reason by the organiser, for example due to illness or force majeure (e.g. Corona Virus), the possible amount already paid will be refunded immediately. Other claims cannot be asserted.
